MYTH

I'm healthy and don't need health insurance



FACT

Health insurance helps keep you healthy! You get checkups, vaccines, yearly bloodwork and cancer screenings at no extra cost. Plus, it pays part of your medical bills if you get hurt or sick.

MYTH

I can't afford health insurance



FACT

4 out of 5 people can find an Affordable Care Act (ACA) health insurance plan for a payment of \$10 or less per month.¹ And now, if you get your health coverage through your job, your family members may qualify for an ACA plan with financial assistance.

MYTH

I earn too much to get financial assistance



FACT

An additional 174,000 uninsured in Florida can now get financial help. Changes to the ACA in 2021 mean you'll pay no more than 8.5% of your family income—and it could be even less.²

MYTH

Finding a plan is too confusing



FACT

Licensed health insurance agents and navigators can share options and help you enroll in a plan—and they won't charge a fee to help. Visit your preferred insurance plan's website to find one near you.
