

Don't Leave Money on the Table

More financial assistance is available for Affordable Care Act (Obamacare) health insurance plans. If you haven't looked lately, here are some numbers you may find interesting.

Get Covered Florida

269,000

is the estimated number of people in Florida with access to insurance through their job whose family members are now eligible for an ACA plan with financial assistance.¹

\$10

or less is what more than 1 in 3 people in Florida paid for their ACA Marketplace plans in 2022.²

174,000

uninsured people in Florida could get health insurance with a \$0 monthly payment³ after financial assistance.⁴

9^{out of} 10

people in Florida with ACA plans got help paying their premiums in 2022.²

Could this be you?



Parents in their 50s with 2 teenagers can earn \$129,000 and only have a monthly payment of \$10 after financial help.⁵



A single 28-year-old could earn \$40,400 and pay \$10 a month for their health plan after financial help.⁵
