## Get Covered Florida

If you're losing coverage through Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), there is help.

You may be able to get financial help paying the monthly cost of an Affordable Care Act (ACA) health plan from the Marketplace.

Here are some important things to know:

You can enroll in an ACA plan during the Special Enrollment Period from March 31, 2023, through July 31, 2024, if you lose Medicaid or CHIP coverage.

ACA plans cover preventive care, doctor and hospital visits, medications, and more, but may have different benefits than government plans, so it's important to reach out for help.





If you don't enroll in an ACA Marketplace plan, other programs that may be available are:

- Florida KidCare: Low-cost insurance for children up to age 18.

- Medically Needy Program: A program that allows Medicaid coverage after a monthly "share of costs" is met. Call 1-850-300-4323.
