Florida Blue needs your quality information, in the form of CPT II and ICD-10 codes, to support improved reporting on clinical outcomes. This enhanced reporting capability can assist you in identifying members in your panel who may need increased clinical oversight or adjustment in their treatment plans to achieve their desired health status.

CPT II codes can be used to identify procedures or clinical activities performed in your office such as review of retinal eye screening reports and medication reconciliation activities performed post-discharge. Using the codes may also significantly reduce the number of medical records requested, which can save you administrative time and money.

The table below lists diagnosis and CPT II codes that should be used to show that body mass index, diabetes care, blood pressure, medication reconciliation, functional assessment, and pain assessment are evaluated.

2026F	CPT II	Eye imaging validated to match diagnosis from 7 standard field stereoscopic photos results documented and reviewed
3072F	CPT II	Low risk for retinopathy (no evidence of retinopathy in the prior year)

3066F	CPT II	Nephropathy treatment - documentation of treatment for nephropathy (patient receiving dialysis, patient being treated for ESRD, CRF, ARF, or renal insufficiency, any visit to a nephrologist).

3074F	CPT II	Most recent systolic blood pressure less than 130 mm Hg
3075F	CPT II	Most recent systolic blood pressure 130 – 139 mm Hg
3077F	CPT II	Most recent systolic blood pressure greater than or equal to 140 mm Hg
3078F	CPT II	Most recent diastolic pressure less than 80 mm Hg
3079F	CPT II	Most recent diastolic pressure 80- 89 mm Hg
3080F	CPT II	Most recent diastolic pressure greater than or equal to 90 mm Hg

1111F	CPT II	Discharge medications reconciled with current medication list in outpatient medical record

1159F	CPT II	Medication list documented in the medical record
1160F	CPT II	Review of all medications by a prescribing practitioner or clinical pharmacist documented in the medical record
1170F	CPT II	Functional status assessed
1125F	CPT II	Pain severity quantified; pain present
1126F	CPT II	Pain severity quantified; no pain present
