

Preauthorization Requirements for Suboxone Film and Generic Versions of Suboxone and Subutex Tablets Removed

In an effort to help combat the opioid crisis, we no longer require preauthorization for Suboxone (Buprenorphine/Naloxone) film, Buprenorphine/Naloxone tablets and Buprenorphine tablets effective **April 1, 2018**. The quantity limits below still apply.

Buprenorphine	2 mg, 8 mg	15 tabs / 90 days
Suboxone (Buprenorphine/Naloxone)	2mg / 0.5mg	120 tabs or films
Suboxone (Buprenorphine/Naloxone)	4mg / 1mg	30 films
Suboxone (Buprenorphine/Naloxone)	8mg / 2mg tablet	90 tablets
Suboxone film (Buprenorphine/Naloxone)	8mg / 2mg film, 12mg / 3 mg film	60 films
