As a reminder, primary care physicians (PCPs) who are eligible for our BlueMedicareSM Quality Provider Bonus Program can **earn double by June 30** for closing their BlueMedicare Medicare Advantage HMO and/or PPO patients' care gaps aligned with specific HEDIS[®] Stars quality measures. Measures include breast and colon cancer screening, care for older adults, diabetes eye exams and rheumatoid arthritis management.

If you're a PCP who is eligible for the bonus program, we encourage you to access our Passport portal's Quality and Efficiency Reporting Portal (QERP) located at availability.com to see your patients' open care gaps. Visit QERP at least monthly to monitor your progress and continue to ensure your BlueMedicare patients receive the care and screenings they need.
