

## Electronic Remittance Advice/835 Registration Is Moving to Availity

Florida Blue's proprietary Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA)/835 registration system is moving to the multi-payer ERA/835 registration process on Availity<sup>®1</sup> effective Dec. 16, 2020. The move from the Florida Blue Passport page to the Availity Enrollment Center will provide a centralized location for electronic transaction enrollments.

If you are already enrolled, you do not need to take any additional action. Providers or their proxy, such as a billing service or clearinghouse, will have access to the system.

The Availity ERA/835 registration process is based on the National Provider Identifier (NPI). Each NPI can be registered for ERA/835s at a single location or Availity mailbox. If your NPI is used to receive ERA/835s at more than one location, this process will continue until you make updates using the Availity registration process and choose the location to receive ERA/835s for the registered NPI.

### Accessing ERA/835 on Availity

Before you can access the registration system, your Availity administrator will need to assign the Transaction Enrollment role to you.
