- Complete and fax a specialty drug enrollment form to CVS/Caremark Specialty or AllianceRx Walgreens Prime at the fax number on the form.

- Fax the prescription for the specialty medication along with the completed enrollment form and a copy of the member's ID card.

- Send prescriptions to **only** one pharmacy.
- If you use CoverMyMeds, be sure to include which specialty pharmacy you used to submit the prescription.
